Guidelines for Junior Matches WINTER 2010/11

Age qualification - Under 16 on 1st January 2010

- Under 13 on 1st January 2010

<u>Boys</u>	4 boys to form 2 pairs, each pair play a 2 set rubber (tiebreak at 6-6) against each opposing pair. $\frac{1}{2}$ point awarded for each set won. U16 - Leagues to play ONE match against each opposing club U13 - League to play HOME + AWAY matches against each opposing club
<u>Girls</u>	4 girls to form 2 pairs, each pair play a 2 set rubber (tiebreak at 6-6) against each opposing pair. $\frac{1}{2}$ point awarded for each set won. U16 - NO League this season U13 - League to play HOME + AWAY matches against each opposing club
<u>Mixed</u>	2 girls + 2 boys, match to consist of 4 x 2 set rubbers (tiebreak at 6-6), the rubbers are 1 x boys, 1 x girls, 2 x mixed. $\frac{1}{2}$ point awarded for each set won. U16 - League to play ONE match against each opposing club U13 - League to play HOME + AWAY matches against each opposing club

The home team must provide 3 new balls for each court.

Girls can only play in Boys' matches if prior agreement has been granted by the opposition and if the club has no mixed or girls' teams.

Please note, if a walkover is given, the defaulting team is penalised 2 points and the opposition is awarded 4 points - see Rule 14(j)

Home clubs please provide some kind of refreshments.

Please note that there should be an adult in attendance at all times.

Please fill in score cards in Home/Away format (eg 6-4, 3-6, 7-6 - home team score listed first).

Clubs must nominate the names of players in the A team if two teams are entered and for A & B teams if three teams are entered.
